3. Supervisory Responsibilities: Supervise summer coaches who work with the Atom, Pee Wee and Bantam and Day Program categories.
4. Spring Camp Coaching: Provide coaching to full time paddlers at 4 week spring training camp in Stuart Florida
5. Fall and winter training: Develop programs with Head Coach to provide off season training including swimming, x-country skiing, running and weight training.
