## January 2023 ADCKC Policy Changes

## Additions:

- 5.13 Competitor Uniforms
  - A. U10, U12, and U14 class competitors must be dressed in a shirt in the CKC DDC approved colours of their club
  - B. U16, U18, Junior, Senior, Open, and Masters competitors must be uniformly dressed in CKC DDC approved colours and design of their club.

## Amendments:

- 5.4. Safety Boats
  - A. The Division provides safety boats for sanctioned regattas through contracted services. For events held away from Lake Banook, it is the responsibility of the host Club to supply one safety boat spotter with a standard <del>boat</del> Personal Floatation Device (PFD) <del>and sufficient fuel</del> to remain on the water during all events.

The ADCKC staff is responsible for overseeing that all required regatta safety assets are available during the regatta. The number of safety boats on the water during competition is based on the requirements of the regatta.

It is the responsibility of the safety boat operator and pick up person to be fully attentive to the racing in their area of the course at all times to allow the quickest response possible to a capsized crew.

The Division will publish a Safety Boat Schedule naming Clubs responsible to supply volunteers for each sanctioned regatta prior to **April 1st**. Clubs must notify ADCKC of their assigned safety boat spotter prior to the regatta entry deadline.

If a club wishes to opt out of the safety boat schedule, they may instead choose to be invoiced for their scheduled positions (other than U10 events) at \$125.00 per placement by the regatta entry deadline. If a club does not provide notice and a safety boat spotter on the day of the regatta they will be invoiced for \$250.00.
